Hello and seasons greetings!

As we move into the month of December, I pray that you had a wonderful Thanksgiving Day and are making headway on all your holiday plans! Here at Lakeview, December also brings with it the season of Advent and the celebration of Christmas!

While Christmas is pretty widely talked about, Advent doesn't have the same popularity. Advent hymns aren't nearly as snappy as Christmas Carols and I don't know of any cartoon Advent specials that play on TV every year, but Advent can be a powerful time for us, and it can even make Christmas more meaningful and help our Christmas celebrations be more joyful.

The word “Advent” comes from a phrase that means “until the coming,” and it offers us a time of preparation, a season when we get ready for the coming of the Christ-child. This season of waiting calls on us to take time for reflection and action, both as individuals and as a community,

Each week as we approach our Christmas celebration, we will be reflecting on themes that point us as we anticipate the glory of God being revealed, but this expectation also invites us to actively participate in the kin'dom of God. As *Dr. Cheryl Lindsay* observes:

“God calls us to be liberated and liberators, recipients and givers of grace, hopeful believers and agents of hope in the world.”

In this reflection and action, we find that “Hope is embodied. Joy is embodied. Peace is embodied. Love is embodied. In the birth of Jesus, Christ is embodied.”

As we light the candles on the Advent wreath, as we hear once






I love that quote. There is such quiet bravery in the emotions it mentions... tenderness, courage, hope... and peace. That one hits even more this year, doesn't it? There is an exercise that we sometimes do in Sunday School that can be really powerful, it is just a simple question (that has no simple answer, of course)... *What does Peace feel like to you?* Start small and remember the key words in that question are FEEL and YOU. So, what does Peace feel like to you?



As we move into Advent let's take that question with us to help us in our preparations. Each week find some time to ask yourself, *What does HOPE feel like to me? What does PEACE feel like to me? What does JOY feel like to me? What does LOVE feel like to me?* The good news is there are no right or wrong answers, heck, there may not even BE answers for some of it... but Advent is a time set apart for the purpose of preparing ourselves for what is to come - the birth of a child that would teach that LOVE is the way forward. Through all the pain and suffering, in good times and in bad... just love.

This year in Sunday School we have been learning about the ideas of *Hesed* and *Agape* - dramatically simplified, they are both versions of Unconditional Love, the kind of love that God has for all of creation, the kind of love that Jesus taught about in his words and with his actions. We are looking forward to using the themes of Advent to further explore these beautiful concepts.



This year during Advent our Sunday School classes will get a chance to sing in our Children and Family choir, to learn new songs on our kid's handbells, to work on a brand new Christmas play, to do some yoga and become more familiar with the stories of Jesus's birth from the Gospels of Luke and Matthew.

Our 2nd Sunday Funday for the month of December (12/10) is one for everyone!!! Please meet in the kitchen area of the CE/Preschool wing after worship to join us as we decorate cookies, drink hot chocolate and take a moment out of our busy schedules to sit and talk with each other. The Christmas Fund is Lakeview's December mission of the month. This UCC fund provides financial aid to retired and active ministers, as well as retired lay employees, their surviving spouses and children. This mission is one of the five all-church missions of the UCC that we support annually.

The Christmas Fund:

- Provides bonus checks at Christmas to low-income retired clergy families and widowed spouses.
- Supplements pensions of low- income retired clergy and widowed spouses.
- Provides emergency grants for financial crises in the lives of active and retired clergy.
- Pays or subsidizes some health plan and insurance costs for low-income retired and disabled clergy and lay employees of the Church.

Please consider donating to our December mission. Your contributions to this fund allow you to be a blessing for those who have served or are currently serving us in the United Church of Christ's ministry. The 2023 theme for this offering is "Grace Upon Grace: From Christ's Fullness we have received grace upon grace." John 1:16. 2023 Lakeview Capital Campaign AS WE LIGHT THE WAY– DECEMBER 2023



Greetings from the Capital Campaign Committee! As you may be aware, we “lit the lamp” on January 16, 2022 to officially begin the Capital Campaign to pay for the second mortgage from the Cornerstone Fund. Remember, it is never too late to complete an Intention-to-Give card. Every single one counts toward our goal! **So far 15 cards have been received. If you are new to Lakeview, there is an opportunity for you to pledge on the 2024 pledge cards.**

There is good news as the actual amount of the loan now stands at **\$68,384.18** (as of November 1st) since we have been making a monthly payment of \$1,043.29 and we borrowed less than the anticipated amount. Also, Lakeview has received **\$123,421.47** in gifts to the campaign as of November 12th. **THANK YOU!!**

There was an additional balloon payment of \$20,000 paid toward the principal on May 3, 2022 through funds we receive from the Burgett Estate. Also, Executive Council authorized an additional balloon payment of \$40,000.00 which was credited to the mortgage on September 1, 2022. An additional \$20,000.00 was invested with the Cornerstone Fund. That investment matured earning \$98.74 interest and has been deposited in the checking account to make part of the balloon payment in April. **The 2023 balloon payment of \$40,000 was sent to Cornerstone Fund on April 5, 2023.**

Each month in the LINK we will be giving you an update on our progress. You can also look for the Lamp post. The small white board attached to it shows the total amount collected. The total amount pledged as of October 10th is \$145,120.18. **AWESOME!**
