### FROM TODD'S DESK

If I speak with human eloquence and angelic ecstasy but don't love, I'm nothing but the creaking of a rusty gate. If I speak God's Word with power, revealing all his mysteries and making everything plain as day, and if I have faith that says to a mountain, "Jump," and it jumps, but I don't love, I'm nothing. If I give everything I own to the poor and even go to the stake to be burned as a martyr, but I don't love, I've gotten nowhere. So, no matter what I say, what I believe, and what I do, I'm bankrupt without love.

-1 Cor 13:1-3 The Message

Happy November to you all! It's a busy time of the year with All Saints Sunday, Thanksgiving, the major sports are all playing... And, as we all know from the glut of TV commercials and stories in our news feeds, there is also an election taking place.

And as we find ourselves in the midst of a harsh and divisive election season, we have to remember that when the votes are counted and the winners and losers are named, "We are not red people or blue people or green people or purple people, we are God's people!" Because no matter what happens, we are first and foremost children of God, and that is bigger than country or party.

Paul reminds us in this familiar and challenging portion of his letter to the Corinthians that no matter what we do, if we do it without love it is 'nothing' 'nowhere' and 'bankrupt.' Because we are part of something more, we are the church and as Paul tells us at

# **CYF** (Children, Youth and Family Ministry)

Wow. This year has been... a lot. My original plan for this article was to tie together our last series about Acts of Kindness, this month's main topics of gratitude and thankfulness and start to tease about all the fun activities we have planned for Advent this year, but I found I was really struggling with it. For so many people this past year has been absolutely brutal - around the globe and in our own communities, the suffering is deafening and over-whelming. So what do we do? How do we not just continue to make it through the day, but to make a difference?

We keep showing up. We show up for ourselves and for others. Our faith is constantly calling on us to be there for each other, to see the good - and the God - in all of creation. We talk in Sunday School a lot (seriously, all the time... the kids are likely sick of hearing this from us) that God does not call us to be perfect. God calls us to be open and loving - and while that sounds straightforward on paper, we all know it can be so hard in reality.

So this month let's focus on finding a deeper (probably quieter) gratitude in the small moments of connection. At the end of the day, can you think of a moment that you connected with yourself? (You can totally count doing this daily reflection as that moment - so check that box. Yay!) Can you think of a moment you connected with someone else? With God or your faith? That's it. That is all there is to this year's suggested gratitude practice. Let's give ourselves some space this year to recognize that life has been heavy for a while and that there is no clear end to that weight, but that together we can do this.

So we will start - we are so deeply grateful for YOU - all our Children, Youth and Families here at Lakeview. You bring us such joy, hope and laughter. Throughout the year you have been open and allowed us to have some fantastic conversations both in and out of Sunday School and we look forward to that continuing as we close out this year and move onto whatever the future has in store. The hugs, pictures, silly text messages, pillow fights, brilliant questions, stories about what happened during the week, and so much laughter make it all worth it. So, yeah, this year.... We are incredibly thankful for you.

### 2024 Lakeview Capital Campaign

### As WE LIGHT THE WAY- NOVEMBER 2024


Greetings from the Capital Campaign Committee! As you may be aware, we "lit the lamp" on January 16, 2022 to officially begin the Capital Campaign to pay for the second mortgage from the Cornerstone Fund. Remember, it is never too late to complete an Intention-to -Give card. Every single one counts toward our goal! So far 15 cards have been received. If you are new to Lakeview, there is an opportunity for you to pledge on the 2024 pledge cards.

There is good news as the actual amount of the loan now stands at **\$118,946.27** (as of October 4th) since we have been making a monthly payment of \$1,043.29 and we borrowed less than the anticipated amount. Also, Lakeview has **received \$156,914.00** in gifts to the campaign as of October 7th. THANK YOU!!

There was an additional balloon payment of \$20,000 paid toward the principal on May 3, 2022 through funds we receive from the Burgett Estate. Also, Executive Council authorized an additional balloon payment of \$40,000.00 which was credited to the mortgage on September 1, 2022. An additional \$20,000.00 was invested with the Cornerstone Fund. That investment matured earning \$98.74 interest and has been deposited in the checking account to make part of the balloon payment in April. The 2024 balloon payment of \$40,000 was sent to Cornerstone Fund on April 28, 2024 and was applied to the remaining principal.

Each month in the LINK we will be giving you an update on our progress. You can also look for the Lamp post in Natalie's office. The small white board attached to it shows the total amount collected. The total amount pledged as of October 10, 2023 is \$145,120.18. AWE-SOME!
