In the morning you are free to leave as soon as you need to.

Run4Home 5K - Mark your Calendar

Friday. July 4th, 2025 by Family Promise of Warren County/ IHN

The Run4Home 5K and Kid's Fun Run is the largest fundraising event of the year for Family Promise of Warren County. It provides funds essential to support families experiencing homelessness and those at risk in the Warren County Communi-

ty. This year the Run4Home 5K funds are dedicated to Christmas in July as well as continued updates to the new Family Promise Campus.

This 3.1-mile course is in a beautiful, shaded park atmosphere and is suitable for runners and walkers of all abilities. There will be a ¼ mile Kid's Fun Run at 9:30 for children aged 10 and under. T-shirts are guaranteed for those who register by June 13th.

ACTION IN MISSION—(A.I.M.)

The June mission is Family Promise, a cooperative of many faith communities working toward providing intermediate care to homeless families as they make their way through a program of education, job training, life skills preparation, and a housing search. This program is found in 39 states, with 4500 partnering congregations. A majority of these families become homeless because of eviction or family disruption, such as divorce, abandonment, or domestic violence. Given the choice of buying food or paying the high housing costs encountered in Warren County, most families choose food, leading to eviction and foreclosure. Many of the parents have low wage jobs without benefits, and any unforeseen problem such as illness can lead to homelessness. Prescreening of families is done prior to admission to the program to qualify need.

Once in the program, families were being hosted by various churches on a weekly rotational basis until they obtained housing (Lakeview assists St.Patrick's Episcopal Church in Lebanon on Monday nights). During the pandemic, guests stayed in a local hotel (each family had a room) while congregations provided meals only. A day center in Lebanon is where staff had been housed, and this center offers programming, job and housing searches, public assistance applications, showers, and laundry facilities. The center is also the transportation hub, where rides are provided, if needed, for family members to and from school, jobs, and other places.

Fast forward to May, 2024. There is a new headquarters for Family Promise at 600 Columbus Ave., Lebanon. The day center is housed there, and as the guests are now being hosted at this center, a renovated motel where each family has its own room. There is a large kitchen and communal living space for all to relax in the evenings. Lakeview resumed in person hosting duties in July, 2024.

Besides our offering, which can help to defray expenses for so many items needed to operate the program in Warren County, there is another way we can help. Family Promise will hold it's annual Run4Home 5K and Kid's Fun Run on July 4th at Armco Park. Proceeds will support Christmas in July to help children in the program feel ready for school, as well as continued updates on the new campus. Did you know WIC and food stamps DO NOT cover diapers? In Cincinnati alone, there are approximately 11,000 diaper-wearing children who are experiencing some degree of diaper need every month. **Sweet Cheeks Diaper Bank** works with social service agencies to get free diapers onto the bottoms of the babies who need them.

Lakeview will once again be collecting diapers for Sweet Cheeks during the month of July. Please bring in diapers of any size, including open packages or loose diapers (as long as they are in a bag to keep them clean) by June 29th. Their biggest need is for sizes 4 and 5, as well as pull-ups.

We will also be doing a collection on June 29th to specifically benefit Sweet Cheeks. Their organization can use funds to buy diapers and pull-ups at discounted rates.
