This Month's Mission

One Great Hour of Sharing / Queen City Kitchen

Lakeview has two March missions. The first is **One Great Hour of Sharing,** in which we join Christians in seven other denominations to support relief services wherever and whenever disaster strikes in the U.S.A. and abroad, and also to provide long-term development and assistance, refugee resettlement, and social services. Our other mission is the **Queen City Kitchen** (Soup Kitchen), which provides three meals a day to those in need in the inner city. Our funds will go toward the costs of providing five breakfasts this year for 150-200 people each time. Your mission offering will be split between these missions unless you make a note on your offertory selecting one or the other. 
