Mission of the Month Childhood Food Solutions

This small local program provides food for hungry children in a few neighborhoods in Cincinnati on weekends, holidays and summer breaks, when school breakfast and lunch is not an option. This program, in its 12th year, serves over 4000 children by providing food sacks containing high caloric foods that are intended to discourage rapid ingestion, allowing the food to stretch as far as possible. 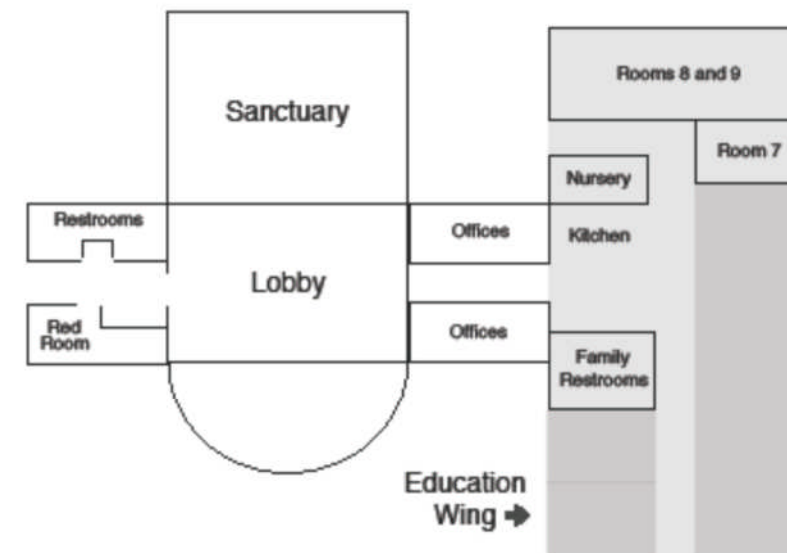
