This small local program provides food for hungry children in a few neighborhoods in Cincinnati on weekends, holidays and summer breaks, when school breakfast and lunch is not an option. This program, in its 12<sup>th</sup> year, serves over 4000 children by providing food sacks containing high caloric foods that are intended to discourage rapid ingestion, allowing the food to stretch as far as possible. 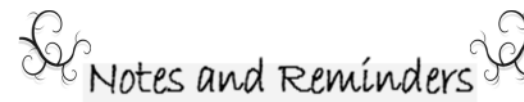

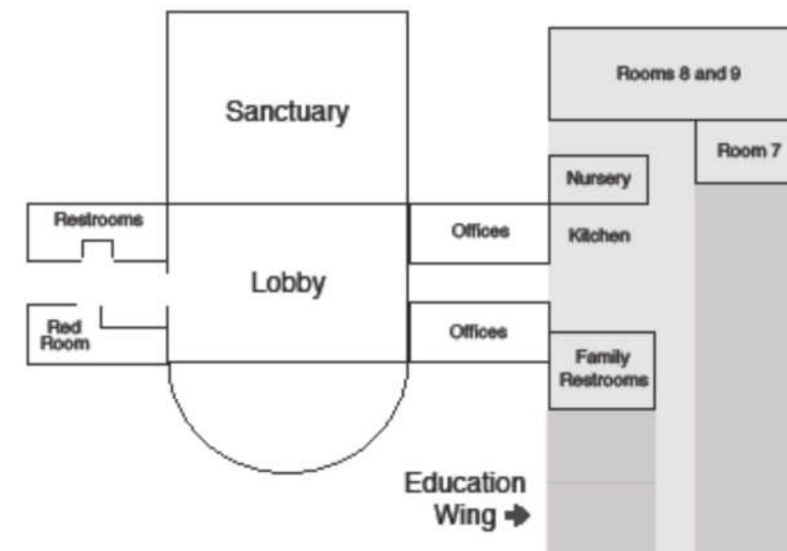
