WORSHIP SERVICES

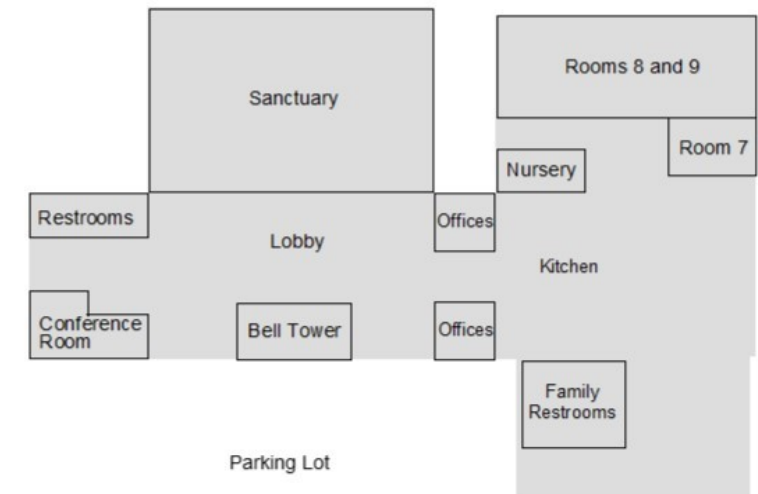
