WORSHIP SERVICES

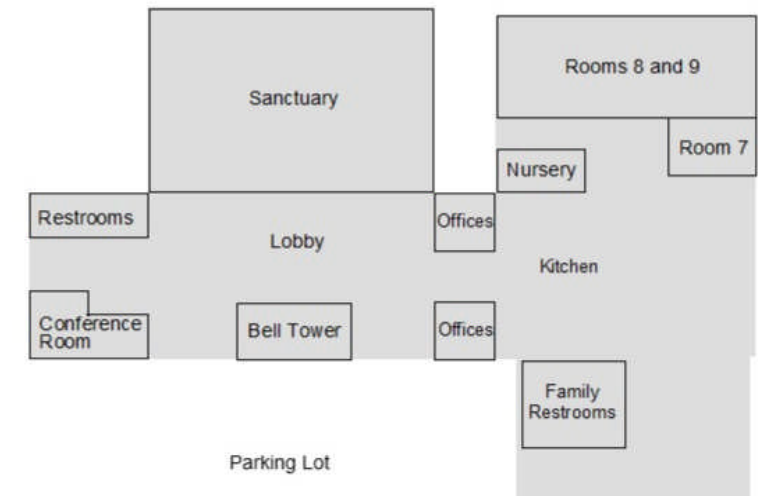
