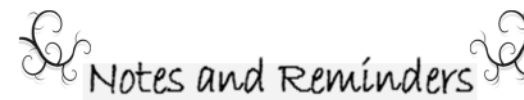
Thursday Evening Book Group

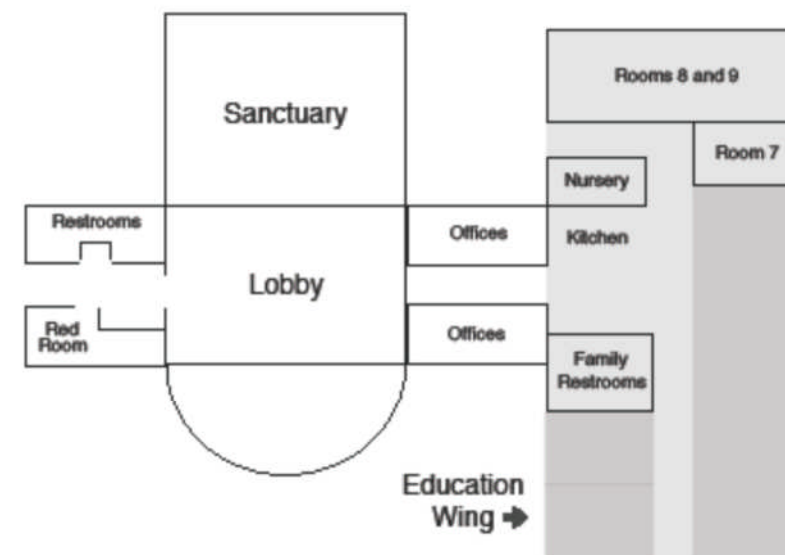
